GUIDELINES FOR USE

Welcome to **Geauga Park District's "Tree House" Camp Site E in Big Creek Park**. This facility may be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis online at least 7 days prior to your stay or by phone at least 1 day prior to your stay. No walk-in camping is permitted. Please refer to the current fee schedule for pricing, as well as complete camping rules, located on our website under Reservations.

Arrival

The "tree house" key must be picked up the day of arrival at Big Creek Park's Meyer Center administrative offices (open weekdays) or The West Woods Nature Center (open daily). **Both locations for key pickup close at 4:30 PM.** Arrival to your campsite is any time after 2 PM. A \$25 refundable security deposit will be required to take the key.

Departure

On the last day of your reservation, depart the campsite by 12 PM (noon).

- BEFORE LEAVING**, • clean facility • carry bagged trash/recycling to receptacles in the campsite parking lot
- return benches to upright/locked positions against the wall • secure all doors
 - drop the cabin key in the dropbox inside the Meyer Center vestibule.

To ensure the facility is well maintained for all who use it, please observe these guidelines:

- Open flames, cooking, small appliances, pets, tents, smoking, e-cigarette use and tobacco use are not permitted inside. Fireworks are not permitted onsite.
- Cars must be parked in the campsite parking lot. Prepare to carry all camping supplies to the site along an aggregate trail; a wagon for this purpose is recommended.
- Fires are permitted in the fire ring only. Campers must bring their own firewood to the site.
- Cutting shrubs or trees, bringing logs in from the woods, disturbing wildlife and defacing park property are strictly prohibited.

Amenities inside

- Maximum capacity: 4 people.
- Wooden bunk bed. No cushion or bedding provided.
- Fold-down bistro set with one (1) small table and two (2) chairs.
- No electricity.

Amenities outside

- Steel fire ring with flip-up cooking grate.
- Stone bench.
- Picnic table.
- One (1) 10'x10' tent pad.
- Restrooms are located in a separate building at the campsite parking lot. They do not have flush toilets or running water.

Please note that reservation permit holders are held responsible for any property damage incurred.

**Reservations must be made at least seven (7) days in advance.
Fees are nonrefundable and nontransferable.**

In the event of an emergency, call 911. For non-emergencies or assistance, call the park office at 440-286-9516. After business hours, call Geauga County Sheriff's Office at 440-286-1234 for a ranger.
